

**VILLAGE OF PAYNTON
BYLAW NO. 5-2011**

**A BYLAW TO AMMEND BYLAW #3-2010 VILLAGE OF PAYNTON WATER
AND SEWER RATES**

The Council of the Village of Paynton in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. Amendment to bylaw #3-2010 shall be added as follows:

1 (a) That clause 6 is amended to read as follows:

6.1 Persons who own or occupy premises drained or that are by bylaw required to be drained into the sewer shall pay for such services a rental rate for services charged in accordance with SCHEDULE "A" attached hereto, as amended from time to time.

6.2 No person shall drain run off water, or basement seepage from a sump pump into the sewer, but will drain it directly outside until it is absorbed by the natural water table.

2. Contravention of the Bylaw

Every person who contravenes any provision of this Bylaw for which no other penalty is specifically provided for in this Bylaws is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to a fine:

- 1) for the first offence, of \$100.00;
- 2) for the second offence, \$200.00;
- 3) for a third or subsequent offence, of not less than \$200.00 and not more than as specified in the "General Penalty Bylaw".


3. Coming into Force

This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on September 13th, 2011.
